Declaring the necessity of constructing certain sidewalks in the City of Bexley, Ohio, requiring that abutting property owners construct the same and declaring an emergency.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIO:

Section 1. That it is necessary to construct sidewalks in the City of Bexley in accordance with the plans, specifications and estimate of cost therefor prepared by the city engineer and now on file in the office of the Clerk of the Council and in the following location:

On the south side of East Broad Street between Merkle Road and Gould Road.

Section 2. That the owners of all lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the proposed sidewalk shall construct, in accordance with the plans and specifications now on file, the portions of such sidewalk abutting on their respective properties within a period of thirty-one (31) days after the service of notice of passage of this resolution; and, if such construction reall not be completed within such period of thirty-one (31) days, then this council shall have the same done and the entire cost thereof shall be assessed upon the property of each defaulting owner and made a lien thereon, to be collected in the manner provided by law, with penalty and interest as provided by law.

Section 3. That the Clerk of this Council is directed to cause a written notice of the passage of this resolution to be served as required by law.

Section 4. That the plans, specifications and estimates of cost for said construction as heretofore filed are hereby approved.

Section 5. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and for the further reason that the immediate construction of such sidewalk is urgently required to permit safe passage by persons using said street and to eliminate existing hazards to pedestrians; wherefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage, and approval by the Mayor.
