

ORDINANCE NO. 3-65

To regulate fences, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful to erect any fence or wall in a Single Family House District (Class 1) or a Two Family House District (Class 2), between the front building line and the street.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful to erect any fence or wall in a Single Family House District (Class 1) or a Two Family House District (Class 2) to a height greater than forty-two (42) inches above ground level, in or along a side lot line, if such side lot line abuts on street, unless said fence or wall is set in far enough to comply with the side yard set back line.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful to erect any fence or wall in a Single Family House District (Class 1) or a Two Family House District (Class 2) to a height greater than seventy-two (72) inches above ground level on any property not included in Sections 1 and 2 hereof.

Section 4. It shall be unlawful to erect or maintain anywhere in the city a fence or wall equipped with or having barbed wire, spikes, sharp points or any similar device, or an electric charge sufficient to cause shock.

Section 5. Any person who violates any of the provisions of this ordinance shall, upon conviction, be fined not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars nor more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars and each day that such fence or wall is maintained in violation of this ordinance shall be deemed to be a separate and distinct offense.

Section 6. That this ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the public peace, health and safety, by reason of the immediate necessity of regulation, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
