

ORDINANCE NO. 5 -65

To amend Section 66 of Ordinance No. 30-51 being an ordinance to establish a traffic code for the City of Bexley, Ohio, said Section 66 being the provision for non-parking areas, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 66 of Ordinance 30-51 be, and the same is, hereby amended by the addition of paragraphs (44) and (45) reading as follows:

- (44) Fair Avenue, north side thereof, Cassingham Road to Remington Road, 7:00 A. M. to 9:00 A. M. on school days.
- (45) Drexel Avenue, west side thereof, commencing at a point 41 feet 6 inches north of the property line on the north side of Main Street, and continuing north for 58 feet, from 7:00 A. M. to 9:00 A. M., Monday thru Friday.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance, necessary for the public peace, health and safety, by reason of hazards to both pedestrian and vehicular traffic, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
