

ORDINANCE NO. 14-65

To provide for the submission to the electors of the City of Bexley, Ohio, of an amendment to the Charter of the City of Bexley by the amendment of Section 7 authorizing the appointment of a Director of Public Safety and a Director of Public Service or Safety-Service Director, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That the question of the amendment of the charter of the City of Bexley, by the amendment of Section 7, be submitted to a vote of the qualified electors of the city at the regular election to be held on the 2nd day of November, 1965, at the regular places of voting in said city between the hours of 6:30 A. M. and 6:30 P. M., said amended Section 7 to read as follows:

"Section 7, The Mayor shall have the power to appoint, subject to confirmation by Council, a Director of Public Safety and a Director of Public Service, who shall exercise all powers and perform all duties that are delegated to and conferred upon such officers by the laws of Ohio not inconsistent with the provisions of this charter and such other duties as may be assigned to either of them by the Mayor, or by ordinance. If the Mayor desires to do so, he may combine these two offices into one, and appoint, subject to confirmation by Council, a Safety-Service Director who shall have the above powers and duties. Any officer or officers appointed under this Section shall serve at the pleasure of the Mayor, and the compensation shall be fixed by Council.

In the event the Mayor does not make any such appointments, or in the event of a vacancy, the Mayor shall have and exercise the above powers and duties."

Section 2. That the ballots for said election shall, at the top thereof, be entitled "City Charter Amendment Ballot" and the question to be submitted on said ballot shall be in the words following: "Shall the amendment to the Charter of the City of Bexley providing for the amendment of Section 7 be adopted?" To the left of said wording in boxes, with appropriate place for marking, shall appear the words, "YES" and "NO", and each voter shall indicate his vote by making a crossmark with a black lead pencil in the place so provided.

Section 3. That the Mayor be, and he is hereby, directed to give public notice of the time and place of holding such election by publication of such notice at least ten days prior to the day of such election, in a newspaper of general circulation in said city.

Section 4. That the clerk be, and he is hereby, directed to mail a copy of the proposed charter amendment to each elector whose name appears upon the registration books of the last regular or general election held in said city, at least thirty days before the date of such election.

Section 5. That the clerk be, and he is hereby, directed to certify a

copy of this ordinance to the Board of Elections of Franklin County, Ohio.

Section 6. That to pay the cost of printing and mailing said copies of said proposed charter amendment and of publishing said notice, there be, and is hereby, appropriated from the general fund the sum of \$ 1000⁰⁰ or so much thereof as may be needed.

Section 7. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure because it must be filed with the Board of Elections in time to be on the November 2, 1965, ballot and for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
