ORDINANCE NO 18 -65

An ordinance levying special assessments for the improvement of Astor Avenue from Sheridan Avenue west a distance of approximately 225 feet in the City of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF CHIO:

Section 1. That the revised assessment of the cost and expense of improving Astor Avenue from Sheridan Avenue west a distance of approximately 225 feet in the City of Bexley, Ohio, by paving the roadway, constructing sidewalks and doing other work incidental thereto amounting in the aggregate to \$11,690.70, as reported to this council on October 12, 1965, by the Service Director of this City and now on file in the office of the clerk of this council, be and the same is hereby adopted and confirmed and that there be and are hereby levied and assessed upon the lots and lands bounding and abutting upon said improvement, the several amounts reported as aforesaid, which assessments are in proportion to the special benefits and are not in excess of any statutory limitation.

Section 2. That this council hereby finds and determines that the revised assessments as now on file in the office of said clerk are in the same proportion to the estimated assessments as originally filed as the actual cost of the above described improvement is to the estimated cost of the improvement as originally filed.

Section 3. That the assessment against each lot or parcel of land shall be payable in cash within thirty (30) days after passage of this ordinance or at the option of the owner in ten annual installments with interest at the same rate as shall be borne by the bonds to be issued in anticipation of the collection of the same. All cash payments shall be made to the treasurer of this City. All assessments and installments thereof remaining unpaid at the expiration of said thirty (30) days shall be certified by the clerk of this council to the county auditor as provided by law, to be placed by him on the tax duplicate and collected as other taxes are collected.

Section 4. That the clerk of this council shall cause a notice of the passage of this ordinance to be published once in a newspaper of general circulation in this City and to continue on file in his office said revised assessments.

Section 5, The clerk of this council is hereby directed to deliver a certified copy of this ordinance to the county auditor within twenty (20) days after its passage.

Section 6. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
