

ORDINANCE NO. 4 -66

To limit truck, bus and trailer parking within the City of Bexley, Ohio.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That no person who is the owner or driver of a truck, bus, tractor, trailer or semi-trailer shall leave said vehicle parked or standing on any street for a period longer than thirty (30) minutes. Provided, however, that this section shall not apply to trucks or trailers used for conveying the necessary tools and materials to premises where labor, using such tools and materials, is to be performed during the actual time of parking such trucks or trailers, nor to motor trucks or buses conveying passengers to any meeting, assembly, church, convention or entertainment during the actual session of any such meeting, assembly, church, convention or entertainment, nor to the actual time during which a motor truck, motor truck tractor, trailer or semi-trailer is being loaded or unloaded or used to deliver or hoist property or merchandise for completion of delivery.

Section 2. Whoever violates Section 1 of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and shall be fined not less than ten (\$10.00) Dollars and not more than fifty (\$50.00) dollars, together with the costs of prosecution.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest date allowed by law.
