

ORDINANCE NO. 16-66

Providing for the purchase of one (1) Packer Type Refuse Body and Truck Chassis for the collection of garbage and refuse for the use of the Service Department and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized, to enter into a contract for the purchase of one (1) Packer Type Refuse Body and Chassis for use in the collection of garbage and refuse, said body type to be fully enclosed and designed to obtain the utmost in the way of sanitary conditions and construction, the same to be fully equipped for use according to specifications, as the Mayor may deem proper and best and to exchange thereon one (1) 1951 Mack Refuse Truck, Motor No. EN 331 16 26, Serial No. A30H2791, with a Garwood Packer Type Body, the same not to exceed \$13,000.00. The City reserves right to select the Truck Chassis and Packer Type Body it considers most adaptable for the service it is to render.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bid after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$13,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said Department is in need of said Refuse Truck and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
