

ORDINANCE NO. 21-66

To amend Section 66.1 of Ordinance No. 30-51, being an ordinance to establish a traffic code for the City of Bexley, Ohio, said 66.1 being the Section establishing no-stopping areas, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 66.1 of Ordinance No. 30-51 is hereby amended by the addition of paragraph (n).

(n) Main Street, north side thereof, from a point opposite the east curb line of Sheridan Avenue, west to the west corporation line.

Section 2. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the new lanes leave no room for such parking, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
