

ORDINANCE NO. 22-66

Authorizing the appropriation of an additional amount to cover the estimated cost of underground wiring for the East Broad Street street lighting system, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the installation and construction of new street lights on East Broad Street with underground wiring thereof together with underground conduit for the future installation of traffic light wiring, in accordance with plans and specifications prepared by Metzger and Blackburn.

Section 2. That the sum of \$15,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund in addition to the sum of \$85,000.00 appropriated in Ordinance No. 18-66 for the purpose of paying the cost of said lights.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the existing lights are inadequate and dangerous and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon passage thereof, and approval by the Mayor.
