

ORDINANCE NO. 23-66

Providing for the purchase of gasoline for the year 1967, and
declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be and they hereby are
authorized and directed, after advertisement according to law, to enter into
contracts for the purchase of gasoline for the use of the trucks and automobiles
belonging to the municipality during the calendar year 1967 to conform to the
specifications set forth and adopted in Ordinance No. 11-36, or an occasional
order of what is termed "High Test" gas. Awards of the entire amount may be
made to one bidder and contracts entered into therefor, or awards may be made
for portions thereof to different bidders and separate contracts entered into
for the respective amounts so awarded. Delivery shall be on order of the Mayor
and shall be in tank on City Property.

Section 2. That the sum of \$9,000.00 is hereby appropriated from
the General Fund for the purpose of paying the cost of said gasoline.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance, necessary for
the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said
emergency being that said gasoline is necessary for the present operation
of various city departments, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force
and effect.
