

ORDINANCE NO. 29 -66

To increase the salary of the Mayor for the term commencing January 1, 1968, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the salary of the Mayor is hereby increased to \$ 9600.00 per year commencing January 1, 1968 in accordance with Section 5 of the charter giving Council the right to increase or decrease the salary providing the ordinance is passed not less than one year prior to the beginning of the term to be affected.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that less than thirty (30) days remain before January 1, 1967, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon passage thereof and approval by the Mayor.
