

ORDINANCE NO. 30-66

To increase the salary of the City Solicitor for the term commencing January 1, 1967, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the salary of the City Solicitor is hereby fixed at \$ 4800 per year commencing January 1, 1967 in accordance with Section 31 of the charter giving Council the right to fix by ordinance the salary or compensation of all officers or employees, provided, however, that the salary shall not be increased or decreased during the term for which he was elected or appointed and the City Solicitor, under Section 42, is appointed by the Mayor and confirmed by Council for a term of one year.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that less than thirty (30) days remain before January 1, 1967, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon passage thereof and approval by the Mayor.
