

ORDINANCE NO. 3-67

Providing for the purchase of an automobile for the use of the Building and Street Department and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they hereby are authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one (1) two-door sedan for use in the Building and Street Department. The City reserves the right to select the car it considers most adaptable for the service it is to render, same not to exceed \$2,500.00 and to exchange thereon one (1) 1963 Ford Falcon, serial No. 3H0LS145324.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bid after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$2,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation for the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said Department is in need of said automobile and said Ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
