We honor his unswerving impartiality as a judge. He possessed the rare gift of meaningful communication with youthful offenders that merited the gratitude of two generations of parents.


We cannot add to the nine favorable judgments accorded him at the polls by his fellow citizens. He has earned and owns the unique title "Mr. Bexley".
