

ORDINANCE NO. 12-67

To provide for the payment of Blue Cross, Blue Shield and Group Life Insurance, and to provide other benefits for Bexley employees, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That effective April 1, 1967, Blue Cross comprehensive coverage and Blue Shield preferred coverage shall be furnished free of charge to all Bexley employees except the Mayor, the Auditor, the Solicitor and members of Council, such coverage to be for the employee, the employee's spouse and unmarried children under 19 years of age residing at home.

Section 2. That Group Life Insurance in the amount of \$1,000.00 each shall be furnished free of charge to all Bexley employees except the Mayor, the Auditor, the Solicitor and members of Council, such insurance to commence as soon as possible and the Mayor is hereby authorized and directed to enter into a contract for the same.

Section 3. That beginning in 1968, and thereafter, February 22 will be a legal holiday in Bexley.

Section 4. That commencing April 1, 1967 and ending December 31, 1967, all Bexley employees will be entitled to a maximum of five (5) days sick leave with pay.

Section 5. That all employees of the City of Bexley who have been employed continuously for over twelve (12) years shall henceforth be entitled to three (3) weeks paid vacation each year.

Section 6. That Sections 1 and 2 of this Ordinance shall not apply to any present or future employee until after he has been employed by the City of Bexley for 120 days.

Section 7. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be repealed and that this Ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety and this Ordinance shall go into full force and effect upon passage thereof and approval by the Mayor.
