

ORDINANCE NO. 16 -67

To prohibit and define obscene literature.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. No person shall knowingly print, sell, offer for sale, give away, exhibit or publish, or have in his possession or under his control any obscene book, pamphlet, magazine, paper, picture, motion picture, image, cast, statuary, drawing, writing or representation or any other article which is obscene.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than Five (\$5.00) Dollars nor more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars for each offense.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
