

ORDINANCE NO. 19-67

To provide for the installation of air conditioning in a portion of the city hall, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor be, and he hereby is, authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase and installation of air conditioning equipment for the east end of the main floor of the city hall, the complete plans and specifications for the same to be approved by the Mayor before advertisement.

Section 2. That said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law, and the sum of Five Thousand (\$5,000.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated from the general fund for this purpose.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance, necessary for the public peace, health and safety, by reason of the necessity for immediate action, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon approval by the Mayor.
