

ORDINANCE NO. 26-67

To increase the salary of the Health Commissioner, commencing October 1, 1967, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the salary of the Health Commissioner is hereby fixed at \$ 250.00 per month, commencing October 1, 1967 in accordance with Section 31 of the charter giving Council the right to fix by ordinance the salary or compensation of all officers or employees.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that less than thirty (30) days remain before October 1, 1967, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon passage thereof and approval by the Mayor.
