

ORDINANCE NO. ³⁴~~22~~ -67

To amend Section 66.1 of Ordinance No. 30-51, being an ordinance to establish a traffic code for the City of Bexley, said 66.1 being the section establishing no-stopping areas.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 66.1 of Ordinance No. 30-51 is hereby amended by the repeal of existing paragraphs (o) and (p) and the addition of new paragraphs (o) and (p), and paragraphs (q), (r), (s) and (t), as follows:

- (o) Main Street, north side thereof, from the west curb line of Dawson Avenue, west a distance of 115 feet.
- (p) Main Street, south side thereof, from the east curb line of Pleasant Ridge Avenue, east a distance of 112 feet.
- (q) Main Street, north side thereof, from the west curb line of Cassingham Road, west a distance of 124 feet.
- (r) Main Street, south side thereof, from the east curb line of Cassingham Road, east a distance of 137 feet.
- (s) Broad Street, north side thereof, from the west curb line of Roosevelt Avenue, west a distance of 190 feet.
- (t) Broad Street, south side thereof, from the east curb line of Roosevelt Avenue, east a distance of 194 feet.

Section 2. That ordinance No. 27-66 in which existing areas (o) and (p) were established, is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
