

ORDINANCE NO. 39-67

To reappropriate moneys from the various appropriations within the General Fund to the various appropriations within said Fund for the current operations of the several governmental departments, as herein specified, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the following sums be reappropriated from the various appropriations within the General Fund to the appropriations within said fund hereinafter set forth, for the current operation of the various departments herein shown, to-wit:

- (a) \$500.00 from 1Z3 to 1Z5 in the General Fund.
- (b) \$800.00 from 2C10 to 2C1 in the Safety Fund
- (c) \$3000.00 from 2C11 to 2C1 in the Safety Fund
- (d) \$100.00 from 2C5 to 2C6 in the Safety Fund.
- (e) \$3600.00 from 4P6 to 4L1 in the Service Fund.
- (f) \$2000.00 from 4P7 to 4L1 in the Service Fund.
- (g) \$1700.00 from 4O9 to 4O8 in the Service Fund.
- (h) \$100.00 from 4O9 to 4O7 in the Service Fund.

Section 2. That the following sums be reappropriated from the various appropriations within the Health Fund to the appropriations herein set forth within said Health Fund for the current operation of the Health Department.

- (a) \$205.00 from 3A3 to 3B2 in the Health Fund.

Section 3. That the following sums be reappropriated from the various appropriations within the Street Construction, Maintenance and Repair Fund to the appropriations herein set forth within said Fund for the current operation of said Street Repair department.

- (a) \$200.00 from 12A14 to 12C8 within said Street Construction, Maintenance and Repair Fund.
- (b) \$900.00 from 12A14 to 12C9 within said Street, Construction, Maintenance and Repair Fund.

Section 4. That the following sums be reappropriated from the various appropriations within the Water Fund to the appropriations herein set forth within said Water Fund for the current operation of the water department.

(a) \$200.00 from 6A3 to 6A1 in the Water Fund.

Section 6. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety in the daily operation of various city departments, and the same shall go into full force and adoption upon the approval thereof.
