

ORDINANCE NO. 2-68

To prohibit the parking of certain vehicles.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to park or store, or permit the parking or storage of, either on public or private property, any vehicle which is not in a condition ready for use, or any abandoned, junked or partially disabled vehicle, unless it is inside a building.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation to park, or permit the parking of, any vehicle on private property in a Class 3 district in violation of the building set back line, except temporarily while transacting business at said location.

Section 3. No person who is the owner, agent, operator, or other person in charge of any vehicle shall permit said vehicle to remain parked, standing or abandoned upon any street for a continuous period longer than twenty-four hours. This section shall not be construed as affecting any other parking regulation now in effect or that may hereafter become effective but shall be construed as an additional parking limitation. The purpose of this section is to prohibit continuous long-time parking and the storage of vehicles on the streets of the City.

Section 4. Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this ordinance shall be fined not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$50.00 for each offense. A separate offense shall be deemed committed upon each day on which or during which a violation occurs or continues to occur.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
