

ORDINANCE NO. 4-68

To delete existing Section 7a. of Article II of Ordinance No. 456, to enact a new section to replace it, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That existing Section 7a. of Article II of Ordinance No. 456 is hereby repealed.

Section 2. That a new Section 7a. of Article II of Ordinance No. 456 is hereby enacted, as follows:

"Sec. 7a. In Class 3 districts no buildings or additions shall be erected until the plans, specifications, plot plans and off-street parking have been submitted to and approved by Council."

Section 3. That this ordinance is hereby declared to be an emergency measure because of the urgent necessity for the proper development of Class 3 districts and for the preservation of the public peace, health, welfare and safety and shall take effect and be in force from and after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
