

To amend Resolution No. 4-68, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, FRANKLIN COUNTY, OHIC three-fourths of all members elected thereto concurring:

Section 1. That Resolution No. 4-68 is hereby amended by deleting Section 5 thereof and substituting in lieu thereof a new Section 5, reading as follows:

"Section 5. That the whole cost of said improvement less one-fiftieth of the whole cost thereof, less the cost of intersections and less one-half of the cost of the improvement along the long frontage, which cost might otherwise be assessed to owners of corner properties where such long frontage abuts the new pavement, shall be assessed in proportion to the benefits upon the following described lots and lands, to-wit:

All lots and lands bounding and abutting upon the proposed improvement which said lots and lands are hereby determined to be specially benefited by said improvement; and the cost of said improvement shall include the cost of preliminary and other surveys, plans, specifications, profiles and estimates and of printing, serving and publishing notices, resolutions and ordinances, the amount of damages resulting from the improvement assessed in favor of any owner of land affected by the improvement and the interest thereon, the costs incurred in connection with the preparation, levy and collection of the special assessments, expenses of legal services, including obtaining an approving legal opinion, cost of labor and material and interest on bonds and notes issued in anticipation of the levy and collection of the special assessments together with all other necessary expenditures."

Section 2. This resolution is hereby declared to be an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of said city, and for the further reason that the immediate construction of said improvement is necessary to eliminate existing hazards to pedestrian and vehicular traffic; wherefore, this resolution shall be in full force and effect from and immediately after its passage and approval by the Mayor.
