

ORDINANCE 7-68

Providing for the purchase of one (1) truck chassis, body, and aerial device for use of the Service Department and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one (1) truck chassis, body, and aerial device as a complete unit for use of the Service Department, the same to be fully equipped for use according to specifications as the Mayor may deem proper and best, not to exceed \$12,000.00 in cost.

The City reserves the right to select the truck chassis, body, and aerial device it considers most adaptable for the service it is to render.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bid after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$12,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said Department is in need of said unit and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
