

ORDINANCE NO. 8 -68

Providing for the purchase of an air compressor for the use of the Water and Sewer Department and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one 125 cu. ft. Air Compressor, mounted on a two-wheel trailer, carrying a manufacturer's guarantee against defective material and workmanship for a period of 90 days; the compressor shall be single-staged, oil cooled, rotary type, having a capacity to deliver 125 cubic feet of free air at 100 P.S.I. per minute, at speed not to exceed 2050 R.P.M., instant acting precision controls, with smooth speed modulation, shall control the compressor from 0 to 100% output. Compressor shall be equipped with oil separator and air receiver, automatic blow-down valve, thermal actuated oil bypass valve, high-temperature shut-down switch, and oil cooler (or an equivalent reciprocating compressor,) The unit shall be powered by four or six cylinder gasoline engine, with approximate displacement of 226 cubic inches, and developing not less than 5 1/2 H.P. at governed R.P.M. Shall be full force feed lubrication, 12 volt electric starter and generator. Hour meter, oil bath air cleaner, oil filter, controls and gauges will be located on one panel. Complete unit will be mounted on two-wheel, spring mounted, trailer on pneumatic tires. An A-frame drawbar, retractable pneumatic tired dolly wheel, and lifting bail will be required. Body will include two full-length tool boxes, fenders and quick-lift side panels. Wheels shall be manufacturer's standard, and tires shall not be less than six ply.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$2,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund, and the sum of \$2,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the Sewer Fund, for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the present equipment is old and may become inoperable at any time, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
