

ORDINANCE NO. 13-68

To appropriate money for the payment of the city's share of uniforms for city employees, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of Nine Hundred Ninety (\$990.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated from the General Fund, and the sum of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund, and the sum of Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated from the Sewer Fund, to be used to pay the city's portion of the cost of uniforms for city employees for the balance of 1968, One (\$1.00) Dollar per week of the cost of said uniforms being paid by each employee.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the employees have no uniforms, and the city is anxious to outfit them with uniforms as quickly as possible, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
