

ORDINANCE NO. 16-68

To regulate boarding or alighting from a vehicle.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,
STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person to board or alight from any vehicle while such vehicle is in motion.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for a driver or passenger of any motor vehicle to leave or enter such vehicle or to open any door of the same on the side next to a moving lane of traffic unless such movement can be made in such a manner as to yield the right of way to all vehicular traffic in the lawful use of the street.

Section 3. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed fifty dollars, and shall pay the costs of prosecution.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
