

ORDINANCE NO. 17-68

To provide for unattended vehicles.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY,  
STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. No person having control or charge of a motor vehicle shall allow such vehicle to stand on any street unattended without first setting the brakes thereon or placing the gear selector in parking position, and stopping the motor of such vehicle, and locking the ignition and removing the key.

Section 2. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine of not to exceed fifty dollars, and shall pay the costs of prosecution.

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
