

ORDINANCE NO. 23-68

To provide for the purchase and installation of radio system equipment and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase and installation of the following radio equipment:

One transistorized main base station for Bexley and Columbus #1; convert existing base for Bexley standby and Columbus #2; one Columbus Fire Department monitor receiver; one transistorized "All County Broadcast" base station; one 60 foot guyed steel tower; three portable two-way radios, each with 2 rechargeable batteries and leather or plastic carrying case; one twelve unit battery charger; five transistorized mobile units; two monitor receivers; one communications center console; one 5000 watt standby power generator; the above to include all necessary antennas, transmission lines, etc. plus complete installation except that in the case of the standby power plant the rewiring of existing circuits or the installation of new circuits will not be included.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$22,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said equipment is needed at once for the use of the Police Department, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
