

ORDINANCE NO. 27-68

To amend Ordinance No. 30-51 to permit right turns on the red traffic signal at Roosevelt, Broad Street traffic, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That Section 10, paragraph (d) 2 of Ordinance No. 30-51 be amended by changing the period to a comma and adding the following wording: "except that the south lane of traffic moving east on East Broad Street may stop and then turn south on Roosevelt Avenue on the red traffic signal, and the north lane of traffic moving west on Broad Street may stop and then turn north on Roosevelt Avenue on the red traffic signal".

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the traffic problems connected with the above amendment are in need of immediate solution, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
