

ORDINANCE NO. 29-68

Providing for the purchase of an automobile for the use of the Department of Public Safety, and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of one current model 4 door sedan, standard size Sedan, complete with standard equipment; the wheelbase shall be at least 117 inches; the engine shall be not less than 300 cu. in. eight cylinder (V-8) gasoline powered unit of not less than 210 horsepower; there shall be automatic transmission; heavy duty special police lining brakes; standard equipment wheels and tires; the electrical system shall include roof light wiring; spot light, outside left side; alternator, 42 amp., minimum; backup lights; battery, heavy duty - 70 amp. minimum; hazard warning system; horn; windshield wipers and washer; toggle switch (cut out for back up and brake lights); door warning light; the color Silver - to be selected by the City of Bexley; there shall be Suspension - heavy duty police; no-slip differential; heavy duty seat; arm rests (right and left); cooling - high capacity radiator; heaters and defrosters; mirror (remote interior and outside left); padded dash; reinforcement on roof for flasher; seat belts; speedometer - certified calibrated - with stop; power steering, not to exceed \$2,500.00 in cost and to exchange therefor one 1966 Ford four door sedan, Serial #6W54B141421 from which the present owner will remove the spotlight and radio for installation in automobile being purchased.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$2,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the said Police Department is in need of said automobile for patrol duty, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect.
