

ORDINANCE NO. 30 -68

To provide for longevity compensation for laborers employed by the city and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That effective October 1, 1968 all common or unskilled laborers employed by the City of Bexley shall be paid for their longevity, in addition to the hourly rate, at the following rates:

- A. In excess of 5 years - \$.05 per hour;
- B. " " " 10 " - \$.10 " " ;
- C. " " " 15 " - \$.15 " " ;
- D. " " " 20 " - \$.20 " " ;

with the provision, however, that subsequent longevity increases in accordance with said schedule shall be made only twice a year on each April 1 and October 1 for those who have qualified therefor prior to each such date.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and shall go into immediate force and effect.
