To revise the payroll schedule of the Bexley Police Department, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That effective December 1, 1968, the payroll schedule for the Police Department shall be as follows:

## Patrolmen:

Section 2. That Blue Cross comprehensive coverage and Blue Shield preferred coverage shall be furnished free of charge to all members of the Police Department for themselves, their wives and unmarried children under 19 years of age residing at home, plus \$1,000.00 life insurance on each member.

Section 3. That the sum of \$3,700.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to pay such increase.

Section 4. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith be repealed, and this Ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that less than thirty (30) days remain before December 1, 1968, and this Ordinance shall go into force and effect upon passage thereof and approval by the Mayor.
