

ORDINANCE NO. 46-68

To fix the bonds of certain officials of the City, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the bond given by all employees except the police and the Auditor-Treasurer shall be a blanket position bond in the amount of \$10,000.00, the company furnishing the same to be subject to the approval of the Mayor and Council.

Section 2. That the bond of the Auditor-Treasurer be fixed at \$10,000.00, and that the company furnishing the same be subject to the approval of Council, which bond shall protect the City with regard to his faithful performance of duty as well as dishonest acts.

Section 3. That all ordinances now in existence with regard to the amount of the bond to be given by said employees, are hereby repealed.

Section 4. That this ordinance is an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
