

RESOLUTION NO. 3-69

A resolution approving the report of the assessment equalization board on objections concerning the estimated assessments for the improvement of all of the alleys north of Ruhl Avenue and east of Cassady Road by paving the roadways with plain Portland cement concrete, constructing storm sewers and doing all other work incidental thereto.

Whereas, the assessment equalization board heretofore appointed by Resolution No. 1-69 passed February 11, 1969 to hear and determine all objections concerning the estimated assessments for the improvement of all of the alleys north of Ruhl Avenue and east of Cassady Road in the City of Bexley, Ohio by paving the roadways with plain Portland cement concrete, constructing storm sewers and doing all other work incidental thereto in accordance with Resolution No. 4-68 of this Council, adopted November 26, 1968 and amended by Resolution No. 5-68 of this Council adopted December 17, 1968, has filed its report with this Council as to its determination of such objections; and

Whereas, Council deems such report proper in all respects; now, therefore,

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. The report of the assessment equalization board hereinbefore recited be and the same is hereby approved and the assessments as equalized by said board and reported by it be and they are hereby directed to be filed in the office of the Clerk of this Council.

Section 2. This resolution shall take effect and be in force from and immediately after its adoption and approval by the Mayor.
