

ORDINANCE NO. 4-69

To increase the sewer rate and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the sewer rates charged by the City of Bexley on all bills issued subsequent to the effective date of this ordinance, shall be as follows:

Up to 150,000 cubic feet - \$2.55 per 1000 cubic feet;
150,000 to 1,050,000 cubic feet - \$2.52 per 1000 cubic feet;
1,050,000 to 4,800,000 cubic feet - \$2.46 per 1000 cubic feet;
4,800,000 to 6,000,000 cubic feet - \$2.19 per 1000 cubic feet;
all over 6,000,000 cubic feet - \$1.62 per 1000 cubic feet.

Section 2. That this is an emergency ordinance, necessary for the public peace, health and safety in the daily operation of the various city departments, said emergency being that the City of Columbus has already raised its rates to the City of Bexley, and the same shall go into full force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
