

ORDINANCE NO. 14 -69

To clarify the effective dates of the payroll increases for longevity in the Police Department, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That effective as of April 1, 1969, all increases in pay as a result of longevity in the Police Department shall be computed semi-monthly, and those that occur on or before the 15th of the month shall be effective as to the payroll for the last half of such month and those that occur on the 16th or after of the month shall be effective as to the payroll for the first half of the succeeding month.

Section 2. This ordinance is an emergency ordinance, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the exact dates are not accurately defined, and this ordinance shall go into effect on its passage and approval by the Mayor.
