

ORDINANCE NO. 20-69

To authorize the City Solicitor to designate an assistant to act as prosecuting attorney of the Mayor's court, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the City Solicitor may designate an assistant to act as prosecuting attorney of the Mayor's court whenever the City Solicitor is absent from the city or, in his opinion, it is advisable to do so.

Section 2. That the sum of Five Hundred (\$500.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated from the General Fund to pay the fees of any such assistant.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the City Solicitor needs an assistant to handle a pending case before the Mayor's court, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
