

ORDINANCE NO. 21-69

To authorize the payment of the cost of uniforms for city employees, to appropriate money for the payment of the same, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That effective June 1, 1969 for salaried employees and June 5, 1969 for hourly employees, the City will pay the entire cost of a basic cotton uniform for each city employee using a uniform.

Section 2. That the sum of \$ 500.00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund and the sum of \$ 900.00 is hereby appropriated from the Water Fund, and the sum of \$ 150.00 is hereby appropriated from the Sewer Fund, to be used to pay the cost of basic cotton uniforms for each employee using a uniform, for the balance of 1969.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, and said ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
