

ORDINANCE NO. 27-69

To provide for the purchase of traffic signal equipment and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized to enter into a contract for the purchase of the following traffic signal equipment:

36 Round, tapered Traffic Signal Steel Poles, 11" Diam. 30' long, 3 gauge S3E, complete with pole top; 60 Traffic Signal Heads 8", three section, one-way, complete with fittings for span wire mounting; 4 Traffic Signal Heads 8" yellow and green, 12" red, three section, one-way, complete with fittings for span wire mounting; 9 Traffic Signal Controllers, interconnected 3 dial, 3 offset, complete with flasher, radio interference filter and cabinet; 2,500 ft. of Aluminum covered steel Messenger Wire, 7 strand #8, 15,930# breaking load; 4,500 ft. of Aluminum covered Steel Messenger Wire, 5 strand, #10, 4,532# breaking load; 500 Lashing Rods, aluminum covered steel, 5 feet in length; 150 Preformed Dead End Guy Grips aluminum covered steel for 7 strand #8 messenger wire; 1,500 ft. of Traffic Signal Cable, stranded 3 conductor #14 AWG, polyethylene insulated; 1,500 ft. of Traffic Signal Cable, stranded 5 conductor #14 AWG, polyethylene insulated; 3,000 ft. Traffic Signal Cable, stranded 7 conductor #14 AWG, polyethylene insulated; 4,500 ft. Traffic Signal Cable, stranded 9 conductor #14 AWG, polyethylene insulated; 32 Pedestrian signals with fittings, incandescent type, containing two complete optical systems; 18 Load Relay with base, designed to carry the interconnect pulse between intersections. The complete specifications for the above equipment to be on file in the Mayor's office.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the lowest and best bidder after advertisement according to law. The sum of \$28,000.00 is hereby appropriated from the Street Construction, Maintenance and Repair Fund.

Section 3. This ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that said equipment is needed at once for the use of the traffic control system, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
