

ORDINANCE NO. 33-69

To increase the appropriation to the Police Pension Fund, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of Ten Thousand (\$10,000.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and credited to the Police Pension Fund.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that there is insufficient money in the account to pay our bill from the State of Ohio, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect on its passage and approval by the Mayor.
