

ORDINANCE NO. 35-69

Providing for an increase in the annual allowance to the members of the Bexley Police Department for the purchase of uniforms, and for the repeal of existing Ordinance No. 9-67.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That during the year 1969, and each year thereafter, each member of the Bexley Police Department is hereby authorized and empowered to purchase various articles of clothing to be worn as part of his uniform, as prescribed by the Mayor, not exceeding the sum of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) per member per year; that the invoices for all such purchases be made to the City of Bexley; that the Auditor be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to honor such invoices up to the amount of One Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$150.00) per year for each member of the Bexley Police Department and issue proper vouchers for the payment of the same; provided, however, that the sum shall be increased to a maximum of Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) during the first calendar year of the employment of any member of the Bexley Police Department employed after July 1, 1969.

Section 2. That Ordinance No. 9-67 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. That this Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
