

ORDINANCE NO. 39-69

To appropriate money and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of \$1,500.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and credited to the Health Fund.

Section 2. That the sum of \$500.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and credited to the City Hall Supplies account.

Section 3. That the sum of \$1,150.00 is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and credited to the Civil Service Fund.

Section 4. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that there is insufficient money in the above accounts to pay pending bills, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect on its passage and approval by the Mayor.
