

ORDINANCE NO. 42-69

To appropriate money and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the sum of Three Hundred (\$300.00) Dollars is hereby appropriated from the unencumbered General Fund and credited to the Jeffrey Mansion Fund.

Section 2. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that there is insufficient money in the above account to pay existing bills, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect on its passage and approval by the Mayor.
