

ORDINANCE NO. 9 -70

Providing for the sale of nine (9) walnut trees, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be and they are hereby authorized to enter into a contract for the sale of nine walnut trees on the Jeffrey Mansion property.

Section 2. Said contract shall be entered into with the highest and best bidder after advertisement according to law.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that the trees should be cut before March 31, 1970, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
