

ORDINANCE NO. 13-70

To vacate the alley between North Cassady Avenue and Stanbery Avenue from the north line of Caroline Avenue to a point 118 feet south of the south line of Delmar Drive.

WHEREAS, notice of the intention of this Council to vacate said alley has been published by posting the notice in three public places for more than six weeks, as required by Section 723.07 of the Ohio Revised Code; and

WHEREAS, more than 75% of the abutting property owners have indicated they are in favor of said vacation; and

WHEREAS, Council, upon hearing, is satisfied that there is good cause for such vacation, that it will not be detrimental to the general interests and ought to be made; now, therefore,

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That the alley between North Cassady Avenue and Stanbery Avenue from the north line of Caroline Avenue to a point 118 feet south of the south line of Delmar Drive be and the same is hereby vacated.

Section 2. That the City of Bexley reserves the right to operate, maintain and repair any and all sewers and water lines, and the right is reserved to operate, maintain and repair any other public utilities, if any, now existing on or in said alley hereby vacated, and the right to enter thereon at any time for the purpose of replacing, operating, maintaining and repairing the same.

Section 3. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
