To provide for bids for the collection of garbage and trash and to declare an emergency.
BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:
Section 1. That the Mayor and the Auditor be, and they hereby are, authorized to advertise according to law for bids for the collection of garbage and trash for the period ending July 1, 197.
Section 2. That said advertisement shall provide for alternate bids, as follows:
A. Using equipment owned by the City of Bexley.
B. Using equipment owned by the contractor, together with a bid for the purchase of the four 16 yard Garwood packers on International chassis which are now owned by the City of Bexley.
Section 3. That the City shall have the right to reject any and all bids.
Section 4. That said advertisement shall also provide that the successive ful bidder may withdraw if he is unable to agree with the City on the terms, covenants and conditions of the contract offered by the City.
Section 5. That this ordinance is an emergency measure, necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that it may be necessary to contract for the collection of garbage and trash, and this ordinance shall go into immediate force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
