

ORDINANCE NO. 17 -70

To vacate the first alley south of Broad Street from the east line of Merkle Road to the west line of Gould Road.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. This Council finds that a petition, signed by the owner of all of the property abutting upon the first alley south of Broad Street between Merkle Road and Gould Road, has been presented to this Council praying that said alley between the points named be vacated.

Section 2. Council further finds that there is good cause for such vacation of said alley as prayed for, that such vacation of said alley will not be detrimental to the general interests, and ought to be made.

Section 3. That the first alley south of Broad Street between Merkle Road and Gould Road be and the same hereby is vacated.

Section 4. That the Clerk of Council be and he is hereby directed to notify the Auditor of Franklin County, Ohio of the vacation of said alley herein provided by sending him a copy of this ordinance.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the earliest period allowed by law.
