

ORDINANCE NO. 19-70

To establish a Recreation Activities Fund to be used as a rotary fund for the activities of the Recreation Department where the cost of such activities will be paid by the participants, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, STATE OF OHIO:

Section 1. That the Auditor be, and he hereby is, authorized and directed to open a checking account which will be known as the Recreation Activities Fund and which will be used to pay for supplies, equipment and activities being purchased or contracted for by the Recreation Department, when such Recreation Department expects the cost of such supplies, equipment and activities to be reimbursed by the persons using the same or participating therein.

Section 2. That the sum of \$ 500,00 is hereby appropriated from the General Fund for the purpose aforesaid.

Section 3. That this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that funds which should be deposited in said fund are in the possession of the Director, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
