

ORDINANCE NO. 20 -70

To amend Section 5 of Ordinance No. 14-44, being the ordinance which established a Recreation Board, and to declare an emergency.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF BEXLEY, OHIO:

Section 1. That existing Section 5 of Ordinance No. 14-44, being the ordinance which established a Recreation Board, is hereby repealed and a new Section 5 is hereby enacted, the same reading as follows:

"Section 5. The Recreation Board shall also have jurisdiction and control of the grounds located at the Jeffrey Mansion and those known as Commonwealth Park, and the Recreation Board shall have the power to employ a Director of Parks and Recreation, who is properly trained for the work, and such playleaders, supervisors, superintendents or other officers or employees as they may deem proper."

Section 2. That all ordinances or parts of ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed, and this ordinance is an emergency measure necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety, said emergency being that immediate action is necessary, and this ordinance shall go into force and effect upon its passage and approval by the Mayor.
